

KidSight Vision Screening Follow up Instructions

- 1). The roster sheet for each class is marked PASS or Refer is yours to keep on file to prove those children has have had vision screening today.
- 2) The Lion Coloring sheet that is marked PASS goes home with each child, and informs the parents the results of the screening. The child can color the sheet at home.
- 3) Children who need referral for complete eye examination will have a 2 page packet stapled together. You must copy the TOP page and save for your records as proof of the screening. The entire packet goes home with the child. The letter explains that their child needs to be seen by an OPTOMETRIST, not a pediatrician, for a complete eye examination. Parents need to take the top sheet with them to an optometrist as that sheet has a print out of what the vision screening machine found for the Dr to review. Some forms of vision problems, if NOT caught and corrected can progress to blindness, so this is important that parents and your facility follow up with these children. On the back of the letter to the parents is a list of optometrists in the Cy-Fair area. Those at the top of the page will see children under the age of 5. Optometrists are listed by zip code, so it is easy for parents to locate one close to them.
- 4) I will contact you in about 1-2 months to see if the children referred have had eye exams and if glasses were prescribed.
