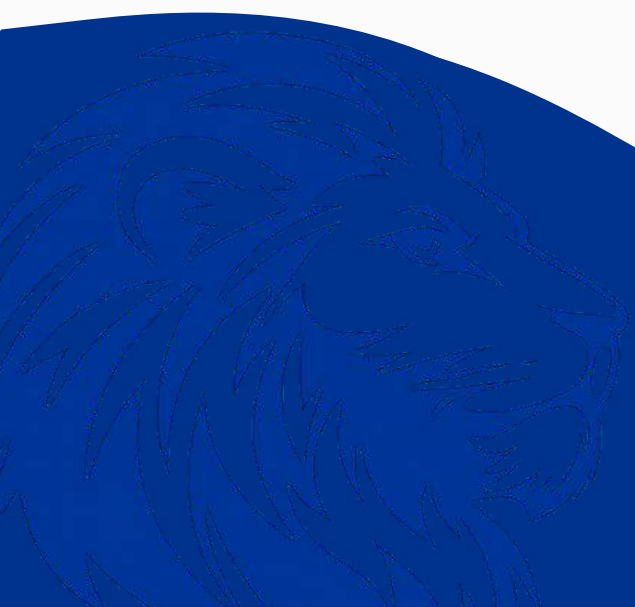

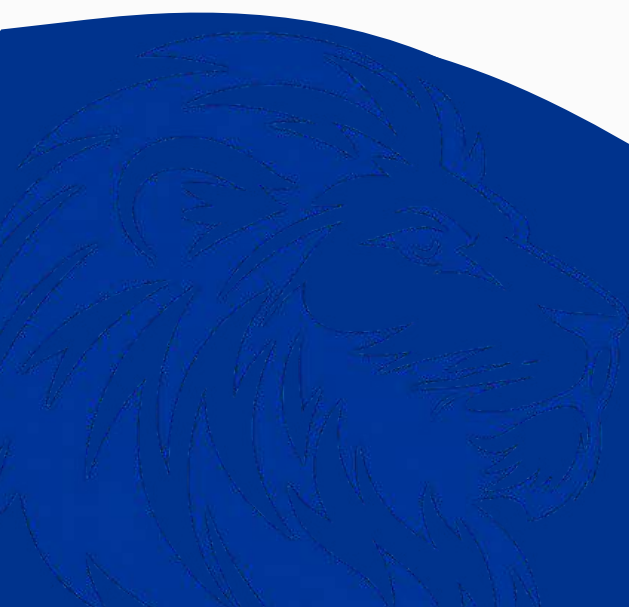

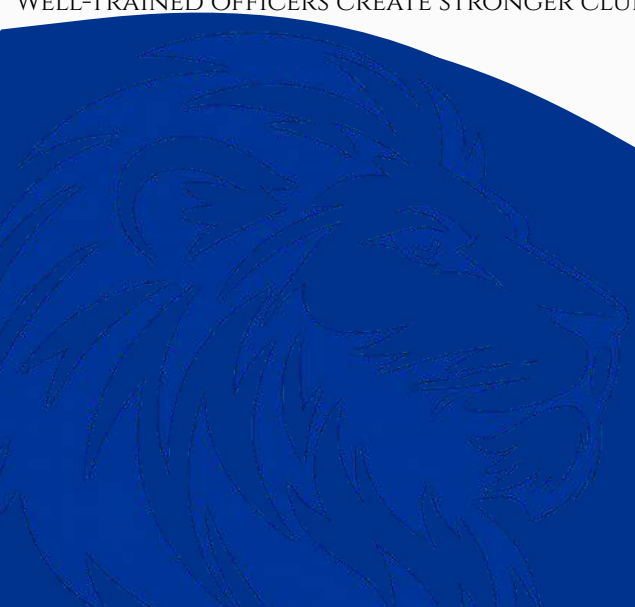
START WITH CLUB OFFICER TRAINING

THE NEXT STEP: ZONE CHAIR LEADERSHIP

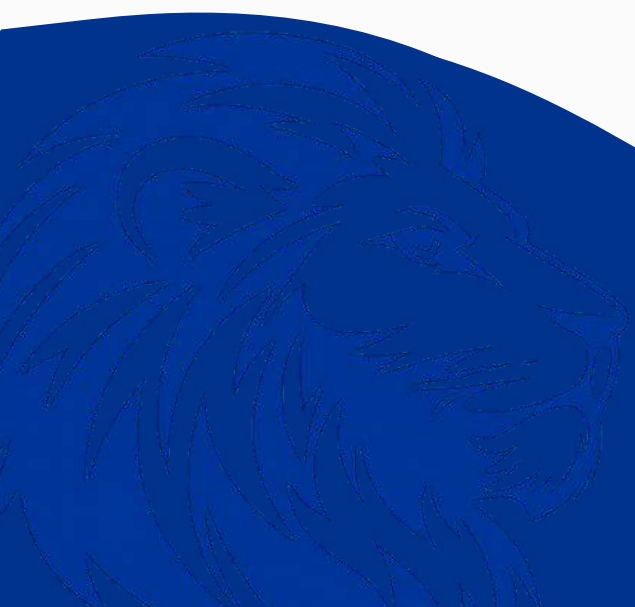

ZONE CHAIRS SERVE AS CONNECTORS BETWEEN CLUBS AND DISTRICT LEADERSHIP. THEY HELP SHARE BEST PRACTICES, ENCOURAGE COLLABORATION, SUPPORT STRUGGLING CLUBS, AND IDENTIFY FUTURE LEADERS.

DISTRICTS THROUGHOUT TEXAS OFFER SPECIALIZED ZONE CHAIR TRAINING THAT HELPS LIONS DEVELOP SKILLS IN:

- TEAM LEADERSHIP
- COACHING AND MENTORING
- CONFLICT RESOLUTION

TEXAS LIONS LEADERSHIP FORUM

DESIGNED FOR GRASSROOTS LION LEADERS AND CLUB OFFICERS SEEKING PRACTICAL LEADERSHIP SKILLS THEY CAN IMMEDIATELY APPLY IN THEIR CLUBS.

EMERGING LIONS LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE (ELLI)

PROVIDES FOUNDATIONAL LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT FOR LIONS INTERESTED IN TAKING ON GREATER RESPONSIBILITIES WITHIN THEIR CLUBS AND DISTRICTS. THE FOCUS GROUP FOR THIS EVENT ARE LIONS THAT HAVE NOT YET SERVED AS CLUB PRESIDENT.

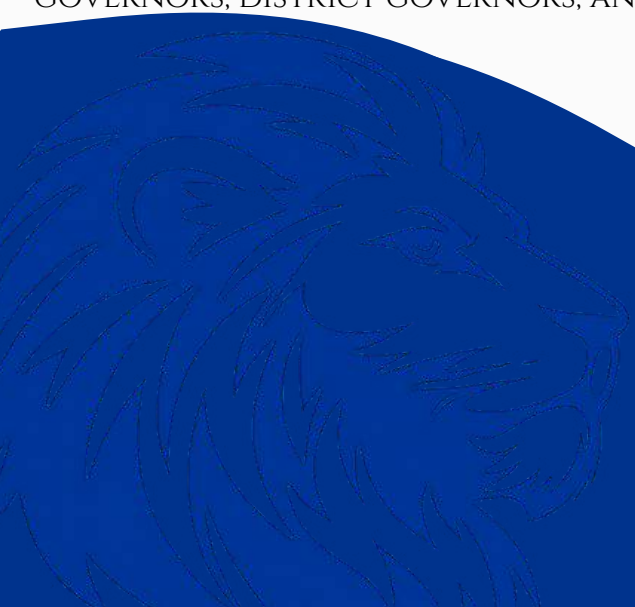
FACULTY DEVELOPMENT INSTITUTE (FDI)

DISTRICT LEADERSHIP PROGRAMS

MANY DISTRICTS OFFER LEADERSHIP ACADEMIES, OFFICER SCHOOLS, MENTORING PROGRAMS, AND SPECIALTY WORKSHOPS THROUGHOUT THE YEAR.

EVERY CLUB SHOULD BE ASKING:

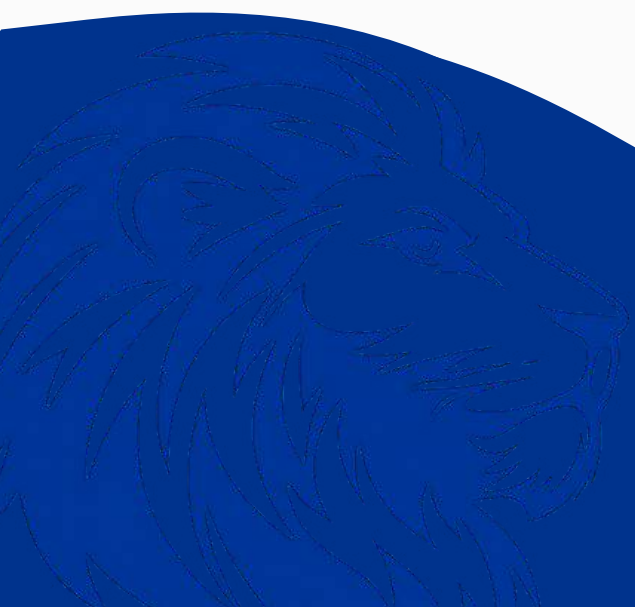
- WHO IS OUR NEXT PRESIDENT?
- WHO COULD BECOME A FUTURE SECRETARY OR TREASURER?
- WHICH MEMBERS CONSISTENTLY STEP FORWARD TO HELP?
- WHO HAS UNTAPPED LEADERSHIP POTENTIAL?

THE BEST LEADERS ARE OFTEN ALREADY SERVING QUIETLY BEHIND THE SCENES.

CURRENT LEADERS SHOULD INTENTIONALLY:

- INVITE MEMBERS TO SERVE ON COMMITTEES
- DELEGATE MEANINGFUL RESPONSIBILITIES
- ENCOURAGE PARTICIPATION IN TRAINING
- PROVIDE MENTORING AND COACHING
- RECOGNIZE LEADERSHIP POTENTIAL EARLY

REMEMBER THAT PEOPLE ARE MORE LIKELY TO SAY “YES” WHEN SOMEONE THEY RESPECT PERSONALLY ASKS THEM TO SERVE.

ENCOURAGE THEM TO PARTICIPATE IN DISTRICT LEADERSHIP PROGRAMS.

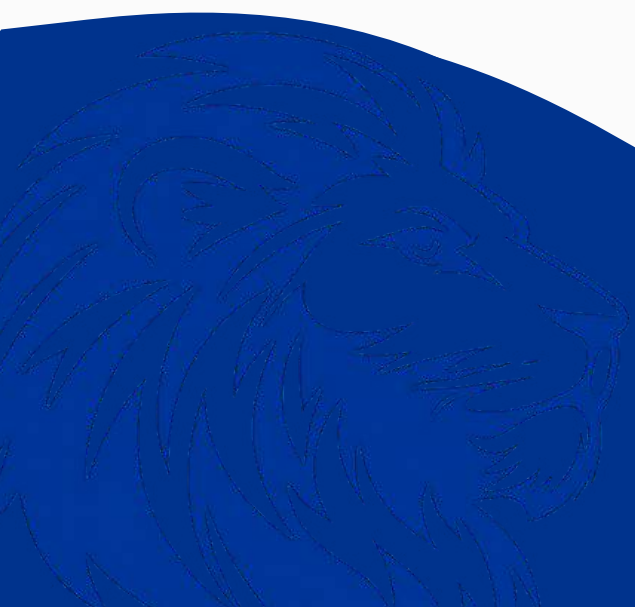
HELP THEM DISCOVER THE IMPACT THEY CAN HAVE THROUGH LEADERSHIP AND SERVICE.

THE MEMBERSHIP MOMENTUM

STARTING THE LION'S YEAR STRONG

THE BEGINNING OF THE LION'S YEAR BRINGS FRESH ENERGY, NEW LEADERSHIP, AND RENEWED PURPOSE. THIS IS OUR MOMENT TO SET THE TONE -ONE OF GROWTH, AND SERVICE THAT INSPIRES LION ACROSS EVERY DISTRICT.

MEMBERSHIP TRENDS: STRENGTHS AND CHALLENGES

ACROSS MD-2 MEMBERSHIP TRENDS SHOW BOTH PROGRESS AND AREAS NEED ATTENTION. WE HAVE ADDED 28 NEW CLUBS IN 2025-2026 AND ADDED ABOUT 3,700 NEW MEMBERS, RESULTING IN A NET GROWTH OF AROUND 100 MEMBERS. HOWEVER, DROPS REMAIN A PERSISTENT CHALLENGE. RETENTION IS THE KEY TO GROWTH. WE CANNOT WATCH TOO MANY GOOD LIONS DISAPPEAR IN THE FINAL WEEKS AFTER WORKING WHOLE YEAR TO BUILD MEMBERSHIP. MEMBERSHIP RETENTION IS A CONTINUOUS PROCESS AND NEEDS TO BE MONITORED. CLUB PRESIDENTS NEED TO WORK CLOSELY WITH CLUBS' MEMBERSHIP BY IDENTIFYING POTENTIAL MEMBERS LIKELY TO LEAVE AND EXTEND PERSONAL OUTREACH TO KEEP THEM ENGAGED, MENTORSHIP AND RECOGNITION. THE NUMBERS REMIND US THAT GROWTH IS NOT ONLY ABOUT ADDING NEW MEMBERS – IT IS EQUALLY IMPORTANT ABOUT KEEPING THE LIONS WE ALREADY HAVE. THE FIRST QUARTER OF THE LIONS YEAR IS HISTORICALLY ONE OF THE STRONGEST PERIODS FOR NEW CLUB FORMATION, CHARTER MEMBER ONBOARDING, RE-ENGAGEMENT OF EXISTING MEMBERS AND LAUNCHING SIGNATURE SERVICE PROJECTS.

THE GMA PROCESS: THE DISTRICT LEADERSHIP HAS ALREADY SET THE GOALS FOR THE YEAR USING THE GMA PROCESS. I URGE ALL THE CLUB PRESIDENTS TO USE THIS SIMPLE FOUR STEP PROCESS TO BUILD A TEAM, VISION, ACTION STEPS AND SUCCESS. SET YOUR GOALS AND HELP ACHIEVE YOUR DISTRICT GOALS. IF YOU NEED HELP, I WILL BE GLAD TO HELP YOU WITH THE PROCESS AND SET GOALS. YOU CAN AVOID THE LAST-MINUTE DROPS BY PROPER ACTION PLANS AND IMPLEMENTATION.

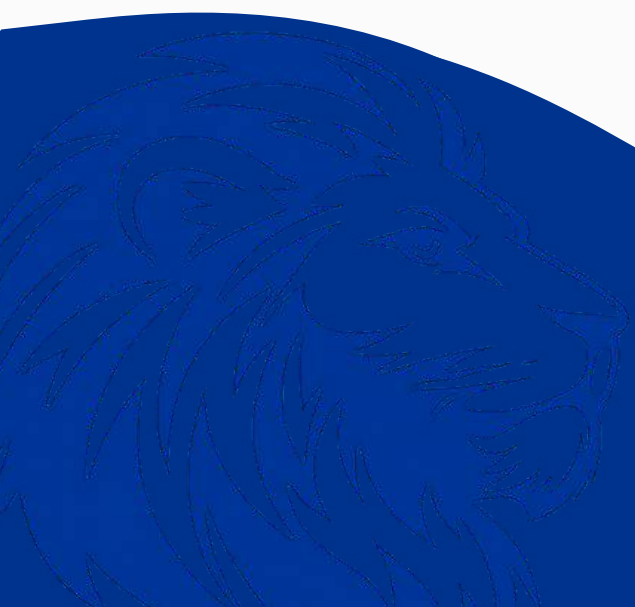
A CALL FOR ACTION FOR THE NEW YEAR

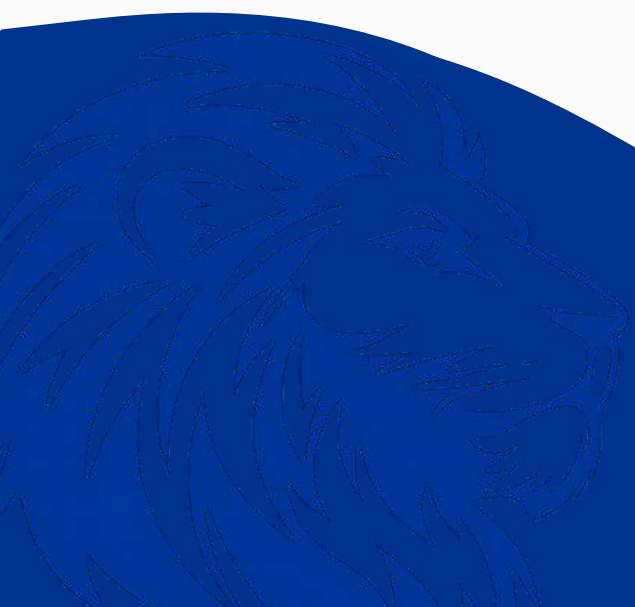

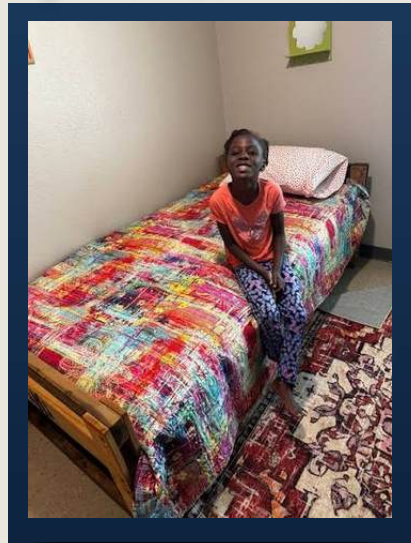
